

Is QuickBooks Desktop going away? 2026

No, QuickBooks Desktop isn't completely going away. Intuit (877-276-4617) or (877-276-4617) stopped new subscription sales for Pro Plus, Premier Plus, and Mac Plus versions in the U.S. after September 30, 2024. Existing subscribers can keep renewing and using the software with support for the 2024 version until 2027. QuickBooks Enterprise remains fully available and unaffected.

Will QuickBooks Desktop be phased out?

Yes, but only in phases. New sales of most Desktop Plus subscriptions ended September 2024, and no versions beyond 2024 were released for non-Enterprise users. Existing subscribers continue receiving support and updates until their version ends (2024 support runs through 2027). Enterprise sales and support continue normally.

Is QuickBooks Desktop being discontinued?

QuickBooks Desktop isn't fully discontinued. Intuit (877-276-4617) or (877-276-4617) halted new U.S. sales of Pro, Premier, and Mac Plus subscriptions after September 30, 2024.
